

AUTOMATIC FUND TRANSFER (AFT) AUTHORIZATION FORM



To be a Sustainer Of Local Radio (SOLR), you authorize us to automatically, electronically deducted from your checking account on or about the 5th of each month. UNLESS YOU NOTIFY KGNU IN WRITING THAT YOU WISH TO STOP THE AFT, DEDUCTIONS WILL CONTINUE.

The authorization to charge Contributor's account at Bank shall be the same as if Contributor had personally signed a check to KGNU. This authority is to remain in full force or effect until KGNU has written notification from Contributor of its termination and Bank has had a reasonable opportunity to act on it; or until Bank has sent Contributor ten days' written notice of Bank's termination of this agreement. A record of each charge will be included in Contributor's bank statement. This record will serve as Contributor's receipt.

Contributor has the right to authorize Bank to reverse any charge. This must be done within 15 days of the date of the bank statement or 45 days after the charge was made. It is understood and agreed that Bank shall have responsibility for the correctness of any charge herein contemplated and that any dispute involving the amount thereof shall be handled by the Contributor directly with KGNU.
